

SEEKING REVIVAL IN EVERY ASPECT OF OUR LIVES

“As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a whole heart and a willing mind; for the LORD searches all hearts, and understands every intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will let you find Him; but if you forsake Him, He will reject you forever” (1 Chronicles 28:9 NASB).

- 1 Knowing how easy it is for human hearts to become passionate about worldly matters, pray that Christians all over the country will intently seek God and will wholeheartedly pursue His will for their individual lives and churches (1 Chronicles 28:9).
- 2 While facing life's spiritual battles, pray that your church family will have a revived desire to depend on God, trusting Him to give the guidance needed in the midst of every struggle (2 Chronicles 20:12).
- 3 As we intentionally seek God for revival, pray that we will do so with the kind of commitment that flows out of both our hearts and minds. Pray that we will seek Him with sincerity and in full assurance of faith (Hebrews 10:19-22).
- 4 In seeking God for personal revival, pray that every Christian within your church family will have a growing desire to daily live in the freedom that comes from repentance—the kind of freedom that overcomes an evil conscience (Hebrews 10:22).
- 5 As many Christians are beginning to recognize the need for a healthy, spiritual change in their lives, please pray that they will see the importance of repenting from sin and returning to a walk of intimacy with Christ (Acts 3:19).
- 6 For those within your church family who are seeking God for personal revival, ask Him to take them by the right hand and provide the needed guidance that will again have them walking toward His eternal glory (Psalm 73:23-24).
- 7 Pray for your Christian friends to experience the kind of revival that covers them with a sober spirit and enables them to be alert when it comes to recognizing and standing against the attacks of the devil (1 Peter 5:8).
- 8 Knowing God's will before seeing anything with his natural eyes, Elijah told Ahab that a heavy shower was coming. He then crouched down on the top of Mt. Carmel and prayed (1 Kings 18:41-44). Pray that your church's leadership will come to know God's will regarding revival for your church family and will pray accordingly.
- 9 Pray that God will give your congregation a clear vision of all that He desires to do in bringing revival into the lives of your church members. Pray that your church family will call on Him and that He will show you great and mighty things that you currently do not know (Jeremiah 33:3).
- 10 Please pray that God will burden your church family with a fresh thirst for His reviving presence. Pray that every member will earnestly seek God and yearn for a fresh touch from His holy, manifest hand (Psalm 63:1).
- 11 Since it is impossible to please God without faith, pray that Christians in your community will experience the kind of revival that grows, builds up, and strengthens their faith (Hebrews 11:6).
- 12 Pray that Christians will be revived in their view of God, even to the point of trembling before Him as they behold His awesome greatness. Pray that the nations will join together in declaring that the Lord Almighty reigns (1 Chronicles 16:30-31).
- 13 Pray that Christians in your community will experience the kind of spiritual desperation that moves them to continually cry out to God, purposing daily to seek His face (Psalm 27:7-8).
- 14 Pray for the kind of revival that moves your Christian friends to constantly remember God's goodness when they pray. Pray that they will join David in declaring that God's "lovingkindness is better than life" (Psalm 63:3).

- 15** Jesus taught, “Blessed are those who hear the word of God and observe it” (Luke 11:28). Please pray that your church family will experience the kind of revival that moves every believer to be more committed in applying the truths of the Bible to their daily lives.
- 16** Pray that your church family will repent of their corporate sins, turning away from the unfruitful deeds of darkness in order to walk with Jesus in the light of His holiness (Ephesians 5:11-13).
- 17** As we pray for young believers across America to experience revival, pray that they will come before God on a daily basis, believing “that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him” (Hebrews 11:6).
- 18** Pray that your church’s leadership will be attentive to all that the Spirit is saying regarding your congregation’s spiritual health. If your church family needs to change any of its corporate ways in order to be more pleasing to God, pray that obedience will take place (Revelation 2:7).
- 19** Please pray that your church family will have a burning passion for God and His Word. Pray that the Holy Spirit will explain the Word to each individual in such a way as to ignite his or her heart with a fresh love for Jesus (Luke 24:32).
- 20** Please pray for the kind of revival within your church family that leaves everyone desiring nothing on this earth except the nearness of God (Psalm 73:25-28).
- 21** Pray that your pastors and church family members will become convicted to communicate with God more regularly. Even as Jesus’ own disciples asked Him to teach them to pray, pray for your church family to have that same hunger to spend time with God in effective prayer (Luke 11:1-4).
- 22** In the busy rush of today’s culture, please pray that the members of your congregation will purpose to slow down in order to wait for a fresh word from God (Lamentations 3:25).
- 23** Please pray that your church family will experience the kind of revival that enables them to stand firmly in their faith. Pray that they will unite their hearts in resisting the devil and will take a unified stand against his deceptive schemes (1 Peter 5:9).
- 24** Please pray that the men of your church will experience revival as spiritual leaders in their homes and at church. Pray that they will be spiritually strong and courageous no matter where they may be (Joshua 1:9).
- 25** Pray that a fresh wave of reverence for God will cover the land. Pray that the men and women of your church will fear God more than they fear the individuals living around them (Deuteronomy 10:12a).
- 26** Pray for the kind of revival that takes Christians back to living according to the ways of God instead of the ways of the world and our culture (Deuteronomy 10:12b).
- 27** Pray that a renewed sense of love will fill the hearts of believers all over this country. Pray that their love for God and other people will reflect His great love for all of us (Deuteronomy 10:12b).
- 28** Pray for revival to come in the area of Christians being obedient in their service to God, offering Him the kind of service that flows out of hearts totally committed to His perfect will being accomplished (Deuteronomy 10:12c).
- 29** Pray that everyone within your church family will “sanctify Christ as Lord” within their hearts and will always be ready “to make a defense to everyone who asks” about the hope residing within them (1 Peter 3:15).
- 30** As God moves in revival and convicts us of sin, pray that we will “cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God” (2 Corinthians 7:1).
- 31** Please pray that God will create within us a new passion to love. Pray that each one of us will love God with all our heart, soul, strength, and mind while also loving our neighbors (Luke 10:27).
