


PRAYING FOR REVIVAL ON THE COLLEGE CAMPUSES OF AMERICA

Let no one look down on your youthfulness, but rather in speech, conduct, love, faith and purity, show yourself an example of those who believe (1 Timothy 4:12 NASB).

Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary (Isaiah 40:30-31).

- 1** College-aged students have had a special place in many of America's great revivals. Pray that today's churches will not despise or look down on this younger generation, but will encourage Christian students to boldly model a genuine faith in Christ (1 Timothy 4:12).
- 2** In a culture that promotes abusive, angry, and unwholesome communication, pray that today's Christian students will exemplify the kind of speech that builds up and edifies those around them (Ephesians 4:29).
- 3** Pray that college students will watch over their hearts with all diligence, and in doing so will turn away from devious and deceitful speech (Proverbs 4:23-24).
- 4** Since spiritually lost millennials are discerningly quick in recognizing foolish, double-minded Christians, pray that Christian students across the nation will be consistent in their walk and excellent in their speech, living lives that are free from deception (Proverbs 17:7).
- 5** Pray that Christian college students will not be careless when it comes to their conduct or ways, but will be diligent in learning and obeying the commandments and ways of God (Proverbs 19:16).
- 6** Pray that Christian students will distinguish themselves before others, not by mastering the ways of the world, but by consistently living according to the pure and righteous principles of God (Proverbs 20:11).
- 7** Pray that on college campuses, Christian students will conduct themselves "in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ" and will stand "firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel" (Philippians 1:27).
- 8** Pray that Christian students will conduct themselves "with wisdom toward outsiders, making the most of the opportunity," and will let their "speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt," so that they will know how to respond to each person (Colossians 4:5-6).
- 9** In this worldly culture, it is easy for college students to be naive and to love being simple-minded. Pray that Christians students will turn away from hating knowledge and scoffing at those who are purposing to truly know, love, and follow God (Proverbs 1:22).
- 10** Pray that Christian students will not forsake wisdom, but will acquire and love the wisdom that comes from above (Proverbs 4:6-7).
- 11** Pray that Christian college students all over America will demonstrate through their daily walk with Jesus that they love God with all their heart, soul, and mind (Matthew 22:37).
- 12** Pray that college students both on and off campus will demonstrate their love for others by interceding specifically and consistently for the salvation and spiritual well-being of every person they consider a neighbor (Matthew 22:39).



- 13** As Christian college students are touched by increasing degrees of lawlessness within our culture, pray that their love for Christ will not grow cold, but will actually burn more passionately as they commit themselves to faithfully walk in the ways of God (Matthew 24:12).
- 14** As Christian college students seek God's will and receive direction for ministry from Him, pray that they will have mountain-moving faith, the kind through which God accomplishes the impossible (Matthew 17:20).
- 15** As students practicing a great faith begin seeing God move in their midst, pray that they will remain humble, having the kind of attitude that moves them to say, "We are unworthy slaves; we have done only that which we ought to have done" (Luke 17:10).
- 16** As Christians students pray and minister together on their campuses, pray that they will be encouraged to press on in their obedience to Christ, being strengthened by each other's faith (Romans 1:12).
- 17** In regard to standing on God's Word in faith, pray that students following Christ will not waver in unbelief, but will daily grow stronger in trusting their lives to Christ while living out His wonderful promises (Romans 4:20).
- 18** Pray that Christian students will see themselves as servants of God and will reflect His presence within them "in purity, in knowledge, in patience, in kindness, in the Holy Spirit, in genuine love, in the word of truth, [and] in the power of God" (2 Corinthians 6:4, 6-7).
- 19** With so many vain philosophies being thrown at them by their peers, teachers, and the culture, pray that the Christian students of America will not "be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ" (2 Corinthians 11:3).
- 20** Pray that Christian students will be sensible and will show themselves to be "an example of good deeds, with purity in doctrine, dignified, sound in speech which is beyond reproach" (Titus 2:6-8).
- 21** Knowing that God brings judgment on the immoral, pray that this generation of college students will hold marriage in honor and keep the marriage bed undefiled (Hebrews 13:4).
- 22** Pray that every college-aged adult living in America will understand that "wine is a mocker, strong drink a brawler, and whoever is intoxicated by it is not wise" (Proverbs 20:1).
- 23** Knowing that God "tests the righteous and the wicked" and hates "the one who loves violence," pray that this generation of college students will pass God's test by turning away from watching the violence found in many of today's movies and video games (Psalm 11:5).
- 24** Pray that America's college students will not have their minds blinded into unbelief by the god of this world, but will have their hearts opened by God to see "the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ" (2 Corinthians 4:4).
- 25** Knowing that their lives are extremely busy and physically taxing, pray that Christian students will be wise about getting enough sleep, while not falling into the trap of sleeping too much (Proverbs 20:13).
- 26** Pray that college students will not be taken "captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the traditions of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, rather than according to Christ" (Colossians 2:8).
- 27** Pray that college students all across America will turn to Christ, denying ungodliness and worldly desires. Pray that they will then "live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age" (Titus 2:11-12).
- 28** In coming to know Jesus, pray that this generation of college students will wait for the Lord, gain new strength, mount up with wings like eagles, run and not get tired, and walk in the Spirit of Christ so as not to become weary in loving and serving their mighty God (Isaiah 40:31).
