

LOVING THE LOST DURING A SEASON OF AWAKENING

God has shut up all in disobedience so that He may show mercy to all. Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways! (Romans 11:32-33 NASB).

- 1 Father, we are so thankful for the way You have shown us mercy by allowing Your sinless Son, Jesus, to die on the cross to pay for our sins. How unsearchable are Your judgments and unfathomable are Your ways (Romans 11:32-33)!
- 2 Heavenly Father, knowing that the response an individual makes to the words of Jesus will be a part of his or her final judgment before You, please guide and empower us to thoroughly share the words of Jesus with our neighbors (John 12:48).
- 3 Almighty God, knowing that men love the darkness of sin, please lift from the eyes of my neighbors any veil of sin that may be keeping them from seeing the light of Jesus and His great love for them (John 3:19-20).
- 4 Father, please help those who are hungering and thirsting for a life filled with joy and peace to believe in and follow Your Son, Jesus, the true "bread of life" (John 6:35).
- 5 Heavenly Father, for those who are hearing the gospel of Jesus for the first time, please protect them from the devil, the one who "comes and takes away the word from their heart, so that they will not believe and be saved" (Luke 8:12).
- 6 Almighty God, please protect my neighbors from the "deception of wickedness." Help them instead to "receive the love of the truth so as to be saved" (2 Thessalonians 2:10).
- 7 Father, knowing that it is difficult for those who are wealthy to enter Your kingdom, would you please protect the affluent in my city from this barrier to the gospel of Jesus (Luke 18:24)?
- 8 Heavenly Father, just as Peter preached under the anointing of the Holy Spirit and saw three thousand souls added to Your kingdom in one day, please allow today's pastors to operate under the same anointing when they preach to the lost living among us (Acts 2:41).
- 9 Almighty God, as Your Spirit is touching hearts today, will you please move people to respond with a sorrow that is according to Your will, the kind of sorrow that produces "repentance without regret" and leads to salvation (2 Corinthians 7:10)?
- 10 Father, knowing that the devil loves to blind the minds of the unbelieving so they cannot see that which is true, please keep the spiritual eyes of those living near me open to the truth of the gospel of Jesus (2 Corinthians 4:4).
- 11 Heavenly Father, please send Your Holy Spirit to convict people in my neighborhood that those who do not believe in Jesus are hanging onto a wrong and sinful view of reality (John 16:8-9).
- 12 Almighty God, please reveal to my neighbors that eternal life comes only through a relationship with Jesus, because "there is salvation in no one else" (Acts 4:12).



- 13** Father, please help the lost realize that You offer salvation to individuals not on the basis of any good works they have performed, but totally according to Your rich mercy (Titus 3:5).
- 14** Heavenly Father, just as Paul willingly adjusted his life in order to communicate effectively with different people, please help the members of my church family make whatever adjustments are necessary in order to share the gospel with those living around us (1 Corinthians 9:22-23).
- 15** Almighty God, before members of my church family begin witnessing to others, please cover us with the assurance that comes from knowing that “he who has the Son has the life” (1 John 5:12).
- 16** Father, please send Your Holy Spirit to touch my unsaved neighbors, revealing to them that just as Satan was judged because of His rebelliousness, even so will they be judged because of their sinful rejection of Jesus (John 16:11).
- 17** Heavenly Father, since Jesus “always lives to make intercession” for those drawing near to You through Him, please move us to be diligent in praying for the lost as well (Hebrews 7:25).
- 18** Almighty God, will you please do a convicting work in my neighbors’ lives today, moving all who are lost to confess out loud their belief that You raised Jesus from the dead to save them from their sins (Romans 10:9)?
- 19** Father, please help my unsaved neighbors understand how trustworthy the statement is that “Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners” (1 Timothy 1:15).
- 20** Heavenly Father, please help us as Your children to be faithful in praying for the salvation of all men, especially those who are in positions of authority over us (1 Timothy 2:1-2).
- 21** Almighty God, knowing that “the harvest is plentiful,” please send out many workers from my church family who will labor hard at sharing the gospel and leading people to Christ (Luke 10:2).
- 22** Father, please help us become extremely bold in encountering and praying specifically for the salvation and needs of those living around us (1 Timothy 2:1-4).
- 23** Heavenly Father, please show my unsaved neighbors the righteousness of Jesus and all that He accomplished on their behalf when He died for their sins and rose from the dead (John 16:10).
- 24** Almighty God, please fill our hearts with intentionality when it comes to actually meeting people in our neighborhoods for the express purpose of making disciples (Matthew 28:19).
- 25** Father, seeing how You expanded the church in Jerusalem by daily adding to its number those who were being saved, will You please show Your graciousness once again by allowing the churches of America to see the same kind of growth (Acts 2:47)?
- 26** Heavenly Father, knowing that every person in every generation needs to experience Your mercy, please use us to carry to every person living in this generation the challenge of fearfully acknowledging Your holy, life-giving presence (Luke 1:50).
- 27** Almighty God, knowing that it is possible for a generation to become completely void of its knowledge of You and the saving work of Jesus, please help us to become even more bold in declaring to those around us the wonderful gospel of Jesus (Judges 2:10).
- 28** Father, please help people see that the event of the cross in the life of Jesus was not foolishness, but that His death and resurrection provide the power for each one’s salvation (1 Corinthians 1:18).
- 29** Heavenly Father, knowing that some people believe their salvation comes from their own good deeds or religious efforts, please show them that true salvation is a gift paid for completely by the gracious, saving work of Christ (Ephesians 2:8-9).
- 30** Almighty God, we definitely need Your anointing when telling others about Jesus. Please direct us to the lost and empower us to boldly share the gospel through the abiding presence of Your wonderful Holy Spirit (Romans 1:8).
