


## MAGNIFYING JESUS, OUR LOVING SAVIOR

The angel said to them, “Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which will be for all the people; for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Savior, who is Christ the Lord” (Luke 2:10-11 NASB).

- 1** Father, Your Word says that Jesus will “reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end” (Luke 1:33). Please send the kind of spiritual revival among us where we submit to Jesus as King, trusting Him to powerfully reign as Lord over every aspect of our lives.
- 2** Almighty God, knowing that the Holy Spirit glorifies and exalts Jesus by disclosing to men the truths of the gospel, please allow the Holy Spirit to point many in my community to Christ today (John 16:8, 14).
- 3** Glorious Father, in magnifying Jesus, please help all men to accept the truth that He is seated at Your “right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins” (Acts 5:31).
- 4** Everlasting Father, thank You that, on our behalf, Your obedient Son “abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.” We praise You today and exalt Jesus our Savior (2 Timothy 1:10).
- 5** Father, understanding that when people come to know Jesus they are able to know You, please help us to boldly spread the truth that Jesus truly is the Savior the world desperately needs (John 14:6-7).
- 6** Heavenly Father, as we purpose to magnify Jesus and bear witness of His sacrificial love for mankind, please protect us from the snares of the evil one (John 17:15).
- 7** Almighty God, please help my church family demonstrate to the world that we truly know and love Jesus by diligently keeping His commands (1 John 2:3).
- 8** Glorious Father, please help us “not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord,” but become even more bold in magnifying Christ before the eyes of a lost and dying world (2 Timothy 1:8).
- 9** Everlasting Father, knowing that Jesus “always lives to make intercession” for Your children, help us daily submit to Him as we purpose to draw near to You (Hebrews 7:25).
- 10** Father, please allow Your grace to touch every one of my Christian friends today, abundantly covering them “with the faith and love which are found in Christ Jesus” (1 Timothy 1:14).
- 11** Heavenly Father, please help my church family not to be carried away by “varied and strange teachings,” but to stay focused on Jesus, the One who is “the same yesterday and today and forever” (Hebrews 13:8-9).
- 12** Almighty God, as you use “living stones” to build Your church, please work in my church family so that the church You are building through us may reflect Your glory and exalt Jesus (1 Peter 2:5).
- 13** Glorious Father, no matter what circumstances or challenges may come our way today, please help us to intentionally magnify Jesus and rejoice in the God of our salvation (Habakkuk 3:18).
- 14** Everlasting Father, as people are often prone to fear either living or dying, please help us magnify Jesus within our hearts so that each of us can join David in declaring, “The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?” (Psalm 27:1).



- 15** Father, as the stories of Jesus are retold this Christmas season, please help both the lost and the saved to wake up spiritually and walk with a healthy expectation of encountering Jesus very soon (Romans 13:11).
- 16** Heavenly Father, please move across my community wrapping people in robes of righteousness, moving them to rejoice greatly in You as Your Son clothes them “with garments of salvation” (Isaiah 61:10).
- 17** Almighty God, please move on my pastor and church staff, making them eager to preach the gospel of Jesus and unashamed in magnifying Your beloved Son (Romans 1:15-16).
- 18** Glorious Father, understanding how all have sinned and fall short of Your glory, please send the kind of spiritual awakening where *all* people are drawn to Jesus and come to know Him as Savior and Lord (Romans 3:23).
- 19** Everlasting Father, because we as Christians have become united with Christ in His death and resurrection, help us to exalt Him by consistently walking in victory over sin (Romans 6:5-7).
- 20** Heavenly Father, please open our eyes so we can see that Christmas is about Your love for a sinful world—Your desire to send a Savior who would be called Immanuel, *God is with us* (Isaiah 7:14).
- 21** Father, as unbelievers see Jesus exalted during this Christmas season, please stir within them the kind of sorrow that “produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation” (2 Corinthians 7:10).
- 22** Heavenly Father, as we remember how an angel spoke to Joseph regarding Mary’s Son, saying, “You shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins,” please send another great awakening to America, continuing to accomplish the saving work You sent Jesus to do (Matthew 1:20-21).
- 23** Almighty God, as Christians all over the world are worshiping You this Sunday, please fill our hearts with an exceedingly great joy as we remember the glorious birth and saving work of Jesus (Matthew 2:10-11).
- 24** Glorious Father, just as the angel told Mary that her son would be great and would be called the Son of the Most High, even so, we affirm in worship today that Jesus truly is great and worthy of utmost praise (Luke 1:32).
- 25** Everlasting Father, we exalt You for having sent Your only Son into this dark world to save us from our sin. Please help us today to not be so caught up in family celebrations that we miss seeing and magnifying this wonderful Savior, who is Christ the Lord (Luke 2:11)!
- 26** Father, seeing all that Your Son has done for us as His followers, we want to thank You for the wonderful, eternal inheritance You have predestined us to experience, all according to Your gracious purpose and will (Ephesians 1:11).
- 27** Heavenly Father, please move all over the world, revealing to both Jewish and non-Jewish people that Jesus is “A LIGHT OF REVELATION TO THE GENTILES and the glory of Your people Israel” (Luke 2:32).
- 28** Almighty God, because Jesus came to seek and save the lost, would You please open the eyes of men and women so they can clearly see the saving work of Christ, understand His great love for them, and respond to Him in faith (Luke 19:10)?
- 29** Glorious Father, since Jesus’ public messages often focused on repentance, please move pastors today to declare this timely message once again to both church members and the lost, encouraging all to repent of sin and crown Jesus as Lord (Matthew 4:17).
- 30** Everlasting Father, please move among my neighbors, convicting them that now is the acceptable time for starting a relationship with You through Jesus—now is the day of salvation (2 Corinthians 6:2).
- 31** Father, realizing that Jesus has opened the door for us to become citizens of heaven, please create within us the passion to keep our eyes on things above as we eagerly wait for the return of our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ (Philippians 3:20).
