

CONTINUALLY PRAYING FOR THE BASICS OF REVIVAL

“If I shut up the heavens so that there is no rain, or if I command the locust to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people, and My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin and will heal their land” (2 Chronicles 7:13-14 NASB).

For us to walk in humility

- 1** Father, please guide us as Your children in humbling ourselves before You by assuming responsibility for the moral and spiritual erosion that has permeated our nation (Ezra 9:6-7).
- 2** Heavenly Father, please help the members of my congregation, especially those who are young, to be clothed with humility and to show respect to our leaders and to each other (1 Peter 5:5).
- 3** Almighty God, please help my church family to live with a daily recognition that pride and haughtiness lead to destruction while humility precedes honor (Proverbs 18:12).
- 4** Glorious Father, please help my church family to “be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kind-hearted, and humble in spirit; not returning evil for evil or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead” (1 Peter 3:8-9).
- 5** Everlasting Father, please help believers within my community to understand the value of humility and how it is “better to be humble in spirit with the lowly than to divide the spoil with the proud” (Proverbs 16:19).
- 6** Father, please help my church family to understand that You require us to “do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly” before You in all of our daily activities (Micah 6:8).
- 7** Heavenly Father, realizing that You are opposed to the proud but give grace to the humble, please help my church family members to humbly walk before You as they daily acknowledge the abiding presence of Your Holy Spirit within them (James 4:6, 10).

For us to pray continually in the Spirit

- 8** Almighty God, please allow prayer for revival and spiritual awakening to spread throughout my community, impressing every congregation to become a house of prayer (Isaiah 56:7; Matthew 21:13).
- 9** Glorious Father, please move every born-again believer within my community to become devoted to prayer, “keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving” (Colossians 4:2).
- 10** Everlasting Father, with the return of Your Son rapidly approaching, please move every believer to “be of sound judgment and sober spirit for the purpose of prayer” (1 Peter 4:7).
- 11** Father, knowing that You will bring about justice for Your children when they cry to You day and night, please move my church family to pray at all times and not to lose heart as they face life’s daily pressures (Luke 18:1, 7).
- 12** Heavenly Father, please prompt my Christian friends to respond to life’s unexpected circumstances by first praying and seeking Your will instead of fretting and becoming anxious (Philippians 4:6).
- 13** Almighty God, please help the members of my church family to be committed to spending daily, quality time alone with You in prayer before getting involved in the busy routines of family life and work (Matthew 6:5-6).
- 14** Glorious Father, please help the members of my church family to work together in praying regularly for everyone, especially for those in positions of authority (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

15 Everlasting Father, please help my church family to pray at all times in the Spirit, especially as they look to You to guide them in praying for all believers (Ephesians 6:18).

For us to seek God's face and obey Him

16 Father, please give my church family a willingness to repentantly seek Your face and Your righteousness until the rains of revival and spiritual awakening begin to fall (Hosea 10:12).

17 Heavenly Father, before the members of my church family seek You in regard to having their needs met, please impress on us first to seek Your kingdom and Your righteousness (Matthew 6:33).

18 Almighty God, knowing that You are not far from those You have created, please move every lost person in my neighborhood to seek You with an earnest desire to truly find You (Acts 17:27).

19 Glorious Father, please help my church family to seek You just like David did when he wrote, "One thing I have asked from the LORD, that I shall seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD and to meditate in His temple" (Psalm 27:4).

20 Everlasting Father, while my church family is continually seeking to experience the strength found in Your presence, please help us not to forget to seek Your face as well (Psalm 105:4).

21 Father, on this Resurrection Sunday, please help my church family not to get lost in its own wisdom, numbers, or wealth, but to seek to understand and know You better through the power of the resurrection of Christ (Jeremiah 9:23-24).

22 Heavenly Father, knowing that You reward those who earnestly seek You, please increase our faith so we may become even more committed in seeking You for revival (Hebrews 11:6).

For us to repentantly turn from our wicked ways

23 Almighty God, please give us a contrite and lowly spirit so we may become even more aware of our need to repent from our personal and corporate sins (Isaiah 57:15).

24 Glorious Father, please help my church family to repent from our wicked ways by genuinely turning back to You and purposing to perform deeds that are appropriate for repentance (Acts 26:20).

25 Everlasting Father, please help those who are repenting from sin and being saved to understand that real salvation is not evidenced just by the words they say but by their willingness to know do Your will (Matthew 7:21).

26 Father, as You convict individuals of sin, please move them to know and be characterized by the sorrow that is in accordance with Your will and leads to genuine salvation (2 Corinthians 7:9-10).

27 Heavenly Father, as we purpose to repent of our sins, please send spiritually healthy believers our way who will help us in restoring our relationships with You and with those we have offended (Galatians 6:1).

28 Almighty God, please help the members of my church family to repentantly grieve over their own sins, understanding how those sins can affect the spiritual health of our congregation for generations to come (Exodus 20:5).

29 Everlasting Father, thank You for being patient toward us as sinners, "not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance" (2 Peter 3:9).

30 Father, please help us in this generation to boldly proclaim to the nations that through repentance and belief in the saving work of Christ, people can still be born again into an eternal relationship with You (Luke 24:46-47).
